



PRODUCT CARE TIPS

Wheels/Tires

Important Wheel Tips*

- a) Re-torque new lugs and locks between 25 and 100 miles and after one week.
- b) Avoid automatic car washes. *(Acid may ruin wheel finish and create pitting.)*
- c) Wash wheels with mild car wash product at least every two weeks.
(Allow wheels to cool before cleaning.)
 - i) Chrome, painted and clear coated wheels: Wax with regular car wax.
 - ii) Polished wheels: Polish at least once per month.
(Recommend name brand polish products. Mother's®, Weno!, Extreme®)

Important Tire Tips*

- a) Check for proper inflation once per week. *(Squeals usually indicate incorrect pressure.)*
- b) Rotate and balance your tires every 5,000 to 7,000 miles.
- c) Check alignment every 10,000 miles or once per year.
 - i) Car pulling to one side or excess wear in one section of your tire may indicate an alignment problem.
- d) **DO NOT DRIVE ON A FLAT TIRE OR USE FIX-A-FLAT® TYPE PRODUCTS. DOING SO COULD DAMAGE WHEELS AND/OR VOID YOUR TIRE/WHEEL WARRANTY.**

Manufacturer Warranty*

RNR Tire Express® does not warranty wheels and/or tires beyond the manufacturer warranty.

WHEELS: Most wheels have a 1 year warranty for chrome peeling. Pitting is caused by improper care and is not covered under the manufacturer warranty.

TIRES: Manufacturer warranties cover defects such as sidewall separation with normal tread wear and are prorated to a percent of remaining tread wear. Manufacturer warranties do not cover road hazards and tire wear due to alignment or other vehicle problems.
